Forasmuch as the strength of this Lord Proprietary
of this Province doth consist in the love and
affection of his People, on which hee doth resolve
to rely upon, all occasions for his Supplies,
both by sea, and land, not doubting of their
duty and assistance upon almost any such
honorable Occasions. Be it therefore
Enacted by the said Lord Proprietary with
advice and Assent of the Upper and Lower Ho-
uses of this present Assembly, That Noe Subsidie,
Customs, Taxes, or impositions shall here-
tofore be levied, assessed, layed, or imposed upon the
inhabitants of this Province, or on their Marchan-
dise Goods or Chattels, without the Consent & ap-
probation of the Governor of this Province, or their
deputies, or the Major parts of them, first
and declared in a Generall Assembly of the
Province.
