

shall at any tyme hereafter, make any Warre
 out of the Limits or Counties of this Province
 without the Consent and approbation of the
 Generall Assembly of this Province first had,
 and declared, The Governour of this Province
 shalbe no waies obliged, or compelled, against
 their Consents to ayde, or assist with their per-
 sons, or Estates in the prosecution, or main-
 -tenance of such warre, but are, and shalbe discharged
 of all attendances or supplye thereof, or in
 relation to such warre, any Lawe, Usage or Custome
 to the contrary hereof, in any wise notwithstanding.
 And Doe further humbly pray that it may
 be Enacted, And Doe it Enacted by the authority
 aforesaid that all Charges arising Under Martiall
 Lawe shall at any tyme hereafter be Executed
 within this Province, but onely in tyme of Camp
 or Garrison, and that within such Camp or
 Garrison, And Doe it further Enacted by the
 authority aforesaid that all Charges arising
 from tyme to tyme by defence of the Province
 against any Invasion of any Enemy, or Enemy's
 or against any domesticall Insurrections or Rebell-
 -ions, against the publick Peace of this Province or
 the Governour or Established Governour, and under
 the Lord Proprietary, and his howes Lords and Pro-
 -prietaryes of this Province shalbe defrayed by
 this Province by an Equall Assessment upon
 the persons and Estates of the Inhabitants thereof,
 any thing in this Act, or in any other Act to
 Contrary in any wise notwithstanding.

An Act Prohibiting the transportation

2. Doe it Enacted by the Lord Proprietary with the
 Advice and Consent of the Upper and Lower
 Houses of this Assembly that what person, or
 persons soever shall at any tyme hereafter pre-
 -sume to transport or cause to be transported
 out of this Province any of the Ordnance Carriage
 for Ordnance, Guns, Shott, powder, or other ammu-
 -nition to the Value of twenty shillings or upwards
 provided, or to be provided from tyme to tyme here-
 -after by his Majesty, or his howes Lords and Proprieta-
 -ries of this Province, or by a Generall Assessment
