That no Person whatsoever within the Province shall by reason of any Petition or Request made or done in relation to the late Alteration of the Government made in the year one thousand Six hundred fifty two, be deemed or hereafter made incapable of Electing, or to be Elected to any future Assembly.

4 by

That No Orders or Decrees of Assembly, or Courts within this Province made, or past since the year one thousand Six hundred fifty four in Cases of Mourning Injunct shall be declared void by Pretence of Irregularity of the power of Government established in the year one thousand Six hundred fifty four.

5 by

That all such as shall within Six months after the Date hereof come or send to the Secretaries Office, and there attending to Conditions of Plantations make their Rights appear shall have warrants granted for so much Land as they shall make appear to be due, and the same Land by them entered up by virtue of Warrants entered in County or Provinciall Courts Provided such Lands be not formerly taken up by lawfull Warrant from his Lordships Office nor reserved for his Lordships use.

6 by

That the Oath of Fidelity shall not be professed upon the people now resident within this Province, but in stead and place thereof an Engagement to be taken and subscribed in manner and forme following. *viz*
I A. B. Doe promise and Engage to submit to the Authority of the Right Honorable Facilius Lord Baltimore and his heires within this Province of Maryland according to his Patent of the said Province, and to his present Lieutenants and other Officers here, by his Lordships appointed. To which I will be ayding and assisting & will not obey or assist any other Authority.
