

The of Tobacco ^{made} ^{is} in this Province, whereby they are disabled to pay for such freight as they engage for, and thereby discouraged to bring their Shippes home, which may turn to the apparent decay of Trade, if not timely prevented. Be it therefore Enacted by the Lord Proprietary of this Province, by and with the consent of this Generall Assembly (That All Tobacco Hogsheds which shall hereafter be made within this Province shall be of the size of forty three Inches in length, and twenty seven Inches in the head, and not under the size of forty two Inches in length, and twenty six in the head, And that what Cooper or Carpenter, or other persons that shall make Tobacco Hogsheds and do not observe the Lawe aforesaid shall forfeit the same (aske, and upon Complaint thereof made) be soe fined for his or their default by each respective County Court where such person, or persons doe inhabit. This Act to continue three yeares, or to the end of the next Assembly, and no longer.

An Act for the Killing of Wolves

3.

Be it Enacted by the Lord Proprietary by and with the consent of this present Generall Assembly, That Every one who shall kill a Wolfe and bring the head thereof to any of the Commissioners shall be allowed one hundred Cornes of Tobacco from the County where the Wolfe shall be killed, And that such Court to whom the Wolfe head shall be brought shall put out the Tongue of the said head to prevent the receipt of Taxes, or otherwise paying for the said head. This Act to continue for three yeares only, and of the next Generall Assembly, and no longer.
