An Act for the advancement of Childrens Estates.

8.

Be it Enacted by the Lord Proprietary by
and with the assent of this present
Generall Assembly. That all Persones
that now have, or shall have any Estate
of Goods Chattels, or Land in their possession
belonging to any who are under age; shall
exhibitt an Inventory and account of
said Estates within three Monethes
after the publication of this Act to
respective County Courts where such Es-
tates shall be, and afterwards yearly, and
if such person or persones who have
such Estates in their hands do not at-
tend and shew as aforesaid present the
Inventory and account of such Estates
aforesaid, then that the whole business be
sent up to the Generall Court. And
the Offendor to be at that Court discomfited.
Which Court upon neglect of exhibiting
as aforesaid, or not good improvement made
of the said Estates shall either suffer the said
Estates
