ensuing paper. vizt Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> of March 1659

tion that the Lord Proprietary hath sent to the Sec-  
etary a Warrant and demand annexed to it to rep-  
the Act of Ten shillings p<sup>er</sup> hoghead. The House  
doe therefore desire and request the said warrant  
and demand be exhibited to the publick view of
