

And after the said Burge^{ss} issued a war.
 to issue from the Govern^{or} ^{and} ^{the} ^{Assembly} ^{of} ^{the} ^{Province} ^{of} ^{Virginia} ^{the} ^{said} ^{Assembly} ^{of} ^{the} ^{Province} ^{of} ^{Virginia}
 to elect three Burge^{ss}es in the name of the
 William Evans, Mr. William Barber, and Mr. Jan.
 Langworth whom they considered and duly elected
 which warrant ensued in his own hand.
 Done in the name of the Right honorable the
 Lord Proprietary to wit and require you to summon
 the high bornen of Saint Mary's County forthwith,
 or as soon as possible to elect and choose three
 able and discreet men to serve as Burge^{ss}es in
 the Assembly for that County, and to make re-
 turn of this warrant with the names of such
 persons so elected as furthest by the eight day of
 March next ensuing. And for so doing the
 shalbe your warrant. Given at Mr. Slye's house
 the third of March 1659. Josias Kendall
 Justice of the Peace for
 Saint Mary's County.

The returned names of
 By virtue of the abovesaid warrant the
 men have bene summoned, and have elected
 Captaine William Evans Mr. James Langworth
 and Mr. Luke Gardner to be Burge^{ss}es for the
 in the Assembly, which I most humbly cer-
 tify this Eight day of March 1659

 night at Elouen a clock at Mr. Slye's house
 Munday 5th of March 1659.

 to the Assembly together with a Commission for
 the trial of an Act formerly made at St. Ignace 1644
 It was ordered that the said Commission and Act
 sent to the lower house.
