

An Acte for the Reviving of certaine Laws
within this Province.

Begyned at a Session of Generall Assembly held at
St. Johnnes in Calvert County in this Province of Maryland
the twenty Seaventh day of October in the yere of
our Lord God One thousand Six hundred fifty and Eight
certayne Actes or Lawes late then and there assented unto
by both houses, and Enacted by Lawes by Josias Brundall
Esq; then Governor of the Province, in his said Proprietary
name Lord and Proprietary therof which said Actes are all
of them Expined being temporary Lawes yet for that tyme
said Acte haue beene judged by divers the Lynge of thir
Limitation and found very necessary and convenient and no
wayes hurtfull either to the Inhabitants or Merchants
trading her but contrarywise more conducing to
the Publicke Good of this Province he is therfore Enacted
and be it Enacted by the authority of this present generall
Assembly, that this Acte entituled an Acte concerning the
Paying of Debates etc. And that other Acte also entituled
an Acte for the Piting of Cakes etc. be likewise this Acte
entituled an Acte for inhibiting Ground Brades and Sconces
And an other Acte entituled an Acte concerning a Regis-
try of Births marriages and burials And that Acte entituled
an Acte concerning Servants that haue Bastards etc
the Acte entituled an Acte for the publication of in
= 1650 And that other Acte entituled an Acte for the
Advaient of Chidren etc to be all and every of t
as they are hereinafter and sett downe rendered
stand in force within this Province according to the
Limitation in the said severall Actes proffred this
Acte to endure for three years or to the end of the
next Generall Assembly
