An Act for the appointment of constable  
officer

Be it enacted by the Lord Proprietary of this Province by and  
with the consent of the Proprietor and Lower house of his present  
General Assembly, that the Justices of peace in every  
County, at their first County Court held after Michaelmas the  
next instant and appoynted constables inhabitants in every hu  
ored or constabulary not being of the garrison by his or  
or Employment of his wife or wife to be constable,  
that hundred or constabulary which shall execute all pr  
and warrantes to them directed. And shall in all things  
the like powder wite in the said hundred or constabule  
any constable hath or ought to haue in a constable  
England by the Law or Custome of England. The said  
Constable shall take oath in manner and forme followinge

If you shall find anye man or woman hath sold and trad by her  
his Loffe in the office of constable you shall see and  
take that his Loffe be sold by constable and deedly kept  
according to you provide you shall arrest all fute person  
as in your power shall furnish or make up the constable  
or other budge of his Loffe you shall doe you  
best endeavour upon complaint to be made to appre  
hend all felon Barraffors Rhytters or persons riotous  
insubordene and if any such offenders shall make any  
just resistance unto you shall haue lawe
