 appointed as aforesaid shall serve as Sheriffs one
 year and not longer This Act to endure for ten
 years or to the end of the next General Assembly
 The lower house have Assented. The upper house have
 Assented

In His Majesty's Military Discipline

For as much as the Ensigning and Trayning up of Souldi-
 =ers in the State of warre and Military discipline is at all
 times most necessary And hath bene in this time of
 danger for want of a better Law than to your bidding been
 most of all neglected to the endangering of the whole Colony
 It enacted by the Right honorable the Lord Proprietary
 with the advice and consent of the upper and lower house
 of this present General Assembly that every personall Lieuten-
 =ant Col. Major or Captaine of any trayned Band within
 this Province shall have power to Enlist such and soe many
 persons inhabiting within their respective and severall di-
 =visions as he shall see needfull and by yeares of pay as they
 shall thinke fit, not being prohibited by their severall Com-
 =mittees or Jurisdictions to be of their trayned Bands where
 persons soe to be Enlisted they shall mustre Exports and
 =trayned up once every three monthes or certaintie and of two
 if the Governour and Council shall see cause soe to doe.
 And every person enlisted into any trayned Band shall be
 bound to appear upon a Summons or Warning given by
 the officers of the trayned Band four tymes every yeare
 or as often as he shall be therunto lawfully requited by
 officers commanding such trayned Band and there mustre
 Exports and trayned according as he shall be by the
 officers commanded And if any person soe Enlisted sum-
 =mons or warned as aforesaid shall not appear according to
