

Ch. St. Condonning the height of
Pontdo'

I Chetel D'Udrogoole in this Province have and
do make sufficient Pontdo above this in found goods
on hand by Cattle and Hough'd and apt to god in and destroy
the said found for prevention of which for the future be
it Enacted by the Good Proprietary by and with the con-
sent of the appoide and lower house of this present Gen-
eral Assembly that all found for found goods within
this Province shall be free goods in height bound by
said goods sufficient and strongly made in the judgment
of two judges but when viewing the same in case of
trepass And in case any horse or horses or other cattle
shall happen to break over such goods as aforesaid or
break it down it being sufficient and strongly made
as aforesaid that then the owners of such horse or
horses or of the cattle shall be liable to pay the les-
sor And in case the said goods be not so high that
then the owners or owners of such goods or
board their own loss committed by the horse hough'd or
cattle as aforesaid And in case any inhabitant in
this Province shall venture to kill any horse hough'd
or other cattle the party so killing shall forthwith
pay unto the party grieved for much tobacco as the
County Court to reward such offence so committed shall
judge the damage or loss so.

And do it further Enacted that all goods or
other damages or losses on either party shall be adju-
dged by the appoide and lower Court where such offence shall
be committed and the value of such damage or loss
so aforesaid shall be left to the said party
Court to upon oath this shall be in force from and
after the first and twenty fifth day of March next
from to divide for three years or to the end of the
General Assembly.
