An Act for Conveyance of all Letters concerning the State and Publick Affairs.

Be it Enacted by the Authority of this present General Assembly that all Letters what so ever to or sent from the Governor or Governour and Council or any his or their Councillors or Justices of the peace concerning the publick Affairs of this Province shall without delay be sent from house to house, the direct way till they be safely delivered as directed; And every person after Receipt of such Letter Delaying to carry the said Letter to the next house above the bearing of half an hour shall pay for a fine to the Lord Proprietary one hundred pounds of tobacco unless it were delivered for sale in the day so that it could not before be might be delivered at the next house or that through sickness of wind or Tempest it could by no means be sent over the Sea or River, if any Plans to be before the house where such Letter shall be delivered And the house to which it ought to be conveyed And be it further Enacted that all publick Letters shall be subscribed by the person directing or sending the said Letter upon the out side of the said Letter thus viz to be sent from house to house And then Subscribe his name the Act to endure for three years or to the end of the next General Assembly.
