


An Explanation of that Fault in an Order
made by Captain William Stone Esq;

Whereas this hath been diversely reported & sayed
concerning the fees due to the Secretary for searching
the records both nowe & heretofore made in the registra-
tion of the same (to have four pounds of tobacco only
per ann and by notwithstanding search made in several
Books without any addition of the former pds
to be annexed to the Search of the last Books found

An Order for the Payment of the
Fees for Customs

This Assembly Considering the Laching etc
Betweene the Lawes made at the Assembly held
the second day of January 1646 at St. Juniper
for the welfare in Consideration of the Customs in the
State granted to his Majt the Right honorable the So
Proprietary to doth undertake the whole charge of the
Government both in warre and in peace and that
of the State confirmed by his Majt's Declaration bearing date
the first day of August 1650 Enacted an acte concerning
Leaving of warre within this Province in the last clause
where it is the whole charge of any warre arising within
this Province to be laid upon the Province by an
equal Assessment upon the goods and Estates of all the
Inhabitants thereof any thing in that Acte or any other acte
to the contrary thereof notwithstanding And further
taking into serious Consideration the Burthen of that State
and the vast charge that hath beene drawn upon her
Province by the late Tyrannous Levies of General Gondar
and his Companie and the greater Expence they might
be
