Provided they destroy not any of her Cattle out of or take
out sure, as they can justly be sayed by their marks to
be their own or by some obligation they are bound to
look after.

And be it further Enacted that the Governour shall
constitute and appoynte Surgeons for many yeres
as he shall thinke convenient in such precinct or places
such wild Cattle be and resort for the destroying
saide allowing two Shares to the said Hunter
Reserving the Allowance and Wages of such Cattle killed
to the Lord Proprietary or who shall hunt at any
time and as often as the Governour shall thinke fitt
and appoynted Betwene the first day of Decem^r
and the last day of February following. And so yere
till the said wild Cattle be wholly killed and destroyed.

And it is further Enacted that it shall be lawfull
after the end of February untill the first of Decem^r
for any Inhabitant of this Province to kill any wild
unmarked Cattle resorting in company with their
Cattle to any of their Companies resorting till that
Allowance and Wages to the Lord Proprietary & use
aforesaid

Provided that this Act do not infringe the
Wages of any Lords of Manors within their
their Manors
