the Governour and Councill to wage warre and maintaine
a warre without the Province for some determinate
tyme by both howes to be agreed upon

Resolved unanimously that the lower howse be moved to
joyne with the upper howse in makinge such an Acte

Upon Reading the Acte for Encouragement of such
soldiers as shall adventure in the defence of the
Country

Resolved that the said Acte be desired to
confirm that Acte in the Province

Then was read the Acte for revivinge certain Lawes
within this Province and in that was read the Acte
therein contained Entituled an Acte for the Regyt of
Cob and Trade

Resolved that that Acte concerning the Regyt of Cob and
Trade be revivd, as alsoe the Acte concerning the
Killing of Wolves

An Acte prohibiting Groundeounds and secondly
An Acte concerning Register of Birthes marryages and
Burialles Revivd

Then was read an Acte concerning Servants that be
Bastards

Resolved that there be a new Acte made concerning
Servants that have Bastards the one be beinge in
it not punishing both parties

An Acte for the Publication of Marryages: Resolved
that a new one be made the former beinge obsolete
and aynded att, the Acte beinge intended att clandestine
Marryages

Then was read an Acte for the Advancement of children
of the poor. Resolved that this Acte be revivd

Then was read the Acte concerning Limiting
Servants tyms

Resolved that into this Acte be inserted these wordes
excepting such Servants which by this Lawe are to
serve onlye four or five years, and that they be added under
after the wordes in the said Acte to witt shall last
is usur'd by me of service of the dictio no of the said
