An Acte concerning the setting up of a Mint
Resolved that the Privy Council be desired to
confirm that Acte in the said Proprietary's name
and that the lower house be desired to joyn with
this house in an acte for the effectuall importation
of money and Bullions into this Province

An Acte concerning the transportation of public
letters

Resolved that the lower house be moved to send more
effectuall waye for the transportation of public letters
and in that of Sherry

An Acte for Ports Duties and M^o of ships
Resolved that the Privy Council be desired to confirm
it in the Proprietary's name

An Acte concerning the killing of wilde Cattle
Resolved that the lower house be consulted with for a more
effectuall waye for the destroying of the wilde Cattle

Resolved that Mr. Daniel Jenifer Messenger be
sent from this house to the lower house to present that
seditionous paper published at Saint Arundell with
the Vote of this house for their censure

Then came a Member of the lower house and presented
this following paper

Whereas at the last Grand Assembly held for the
Province the Burgesses then assembled did humbly
desire that an Acte might be passed by this house
to this effect. That the Members or Burgesses of
this Assembly (and all other Assemblies or assemblies)
have free liberty of speech in delivering their opinions
and censures without prejudice either of themselves
their persons or Estates to any bill or order proposed
or what shall be proposed by them for the
