An Act for the Burgesses
 Expenses

It is Enacted by the Lord Proprietary by and
 with the Consent of the present General Assembly
 that every County shall satisfy unto their respective
 Burgesses all their necessary Expenses the
 Assembly for meat, drink and Lodging for them-
 selves and all charges of Houls and trunks at the
 next ensuing Term as also one thousand pounds
 of tobacco to Hamahood with for house room
 And that John Shanko be paid three hundred
 pounds of tobacco And that Mr. William Breton
 have two thousand pounds of tobacco and Mr.
 John Gittings one thousand pounds of tobacco and
 five hundred pounds of tobacco to John Westlake
 Door keeper

Ordered that this paper be sent to the Lords
 house for their concurrence in it And that Mr. Hoyle
 who carry it desire them to confer this with
 their own papers, and so & what they require
 be not answered in Summe and that they
 signify their Assent or Dissent with speed
 that the Sum may be set before us at the
 next Sessions

 the House have to give their Assent to the said
