An Acte for the Revising Certaine Lawes within this Province

Forasmuch as the same Temporary Lawes made
and Enacted at a Generall Session of Assembly
held at St. Leonards in the County of St. John 1650
being found very convenient and necessary
Conducive to the Publick good of this Province
said Acte many of them were renewed the last year
at a Session of Generall Assembly held at St. Johns
in the County of St. Marys 20. May 1661 and was again
expired. It is therefore Enacted and so it Enacted by
the said Proprietor with the Assent and approbation
of the present Generall Assembly that the Acte intituled
an Acte concerning the Bays of Robarts and that the
Acte intituled an Acte for the killing of wolves
and the Acte intituled an Acte prohibiting ground
Leases and Leases and the Acte intituled an Acte
concerning a Register of birth marriages Burialles
and the Acte intituled an Acte for the Education of
Childrens Statutes all and every of them as they
are here rehearsed and set downe againe renewed
and stand in force within this Province according to
the limitation expressed in the said severall Actes
And forasmuch as likewise sundry Actes were
Enacted at a Session of Generall Assembly held
at St. Johns 20. May 1661 by the Honorable Philip Calver
Esq. his Lords High Governour some of which Actes
being Temporary are now in like manner and
to the limitation expired the which being found
would be hurtfull either to the Inhabitants or
