 Clause Touching Sheriffs a new Act being now  
 agreed on and passed this Assembly Touching Sher-  
 = iffs be renewed And the Acte Entituled an Acte for  
 Military Discipline, And the Acte Entituled an Acte  
 Concerning the Right of the poe, And the Acte entituled  
 an Acte for Conveyance of all letters Concerning the State  
 and Publick Affairs be every of them as here rehearsed  
 and set downe Renewed, and stand in force with full  
 this Province according to the limitation expressed in the  
 said severall Acts this Acte is ordeined for three  
 yeares or to the End of the next Generall Assembly.
