 Assent of this present Generall Assembly that no
 Judgment Bill Bond or other Instrum^t under hand
 writing shall be allowed or pleaded therein any
 Courts of this Province after three yeares after the
 date of such Judgment Bill Bond or Instrum^t as
 aforesaid excepting such Judgment as are already
 had and Bills Bonds or Instrum^t as are already
 made or taken before the end of this present Generall
 Assembly And be it further Enacted by the
 authority aforesaid that all such Judgment Bills
 Bonds or other Instrum^t already taken shall not be
 allowed as aforesaid unless they be sued out or
 returned within the period of time mentioned in the
 Acte Provided that if either Debtor or Creditor be
 out any time out of this Province for full term of
 three yeares either party away & sayne the benefit
 of this said Acte within the period of time after
 their Returne into this Province for the pleading
 Reminding this Acte to endure for three yeares
 or to the end of the next Generall Assembly
