Both houses being met and after the Charge the
had given the Lower house the reason for calling the
Assembly and being licensed to choose their
Speaker the Lieutenant General they departed.

And after some time returned and presented Robert
Blye gent. their speaker who after disabling of
himselfe was approved on by the Lieutenant Genl.

And the Upper house is adjourned
till to morrow morning 9 of the
Clock.
