

then was read an Act for providing at
law: ordered to be sent to the House of Commons
then came the High Sheriff of the County of
Warrington and he turned the writ of Habeas Corpus
Exco. out

the Act for providing at law voted to
pass
then came from the House of Commons an Act for
a Prison at St. Marg.

ordered that this Act be referred to a Conference
with the lower House as also the Act for an Office
to keep the Records in.

then was read an Act prohibiting the Exportation
of Wool. Ordered that the lower House be
desired to strike out these words in the Act pro-
hibiting Exportation of Wools vizt our halfe of the
Wool of France Jackson went to and in read thereof
he put in the Lord Bishop of Exeter's Bill for
to grant any other Encouragement to the said
Jackson. His Majesty desired to insert it.

then was read an Act for the better regulation of the first
born of the Act made at St. Johns 17. The Bill
was by Philip Calvert Esq. who was inhibited the
Act concerning killing with the Battle

ordered that these words in the second clause
of the said Act General be inserted in the said Act
then was read an Act for the raising persons of
Law and Establishing the manner of making
of Law for the future.

ordered that after the words disturbed or
disturbance in the first Clause in the Act entitled
these words by any Person in the words after the
day of March which shall be in the year of our
said 1704 by any person or persons whatsoever
that was named in Conference with the lower House
