Be it Enacted by the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lords Proprietors  
 of and with the Consent of this present General Assembly  
 that the Secretaries Fees shall be for every  
 Yearly 20<sup>0</sup> shill. or  
 For the White and Masters of Ships protest and 0 3 4  
 According to 4<sup>0</sup> 6<sup>0</sup> or  
 For taking Bond of Masters of Ships as above 0 1 5  
 For a Certificate of Masters of Ships or other 0 1 5  
 For discharge of Ships  
 For every Pass that shall be received of him  
 by person departing the Province 2<sup>0</sup> 6<sup>0</sup>  
 For every Schooner that shall come from Virginia  
 and shall not bring a Certificate that they  
 belong to some Ships that that given  
 Bond according to the Act for Navigation  
 and intercourse of shipping the same shall  
 as for a Ship, but in case they do produce  
 such Certificate to go free without paying fees  
 Then was read again the Act substituted as
