

3<sup>rd</sup> The order of Dismissal was granted upon  
 false and forged Jurisf. of the Court of  
 Surprises for whereas in the 1<sup>st</sup> Evidence it is  
 Jurisf. that the 1<sup>st</sup> Recognizance before a Justice  
 Baltimore was in view of the Hon. J. G. H. and  
 Snowcraft in Maryland. It is apparent by a  
 date of the 1<sup>st</sup> Letter of the 1<sup>st</sup> Justice. It is  
 granted compared with the Recognizance of  
 that the Recognizance was out into many  
 months after the date of the 1<sup>st</sup> Justice. It  
 is also in Jurisf. for diverse Jurisf. of Snow  
 from the 1<sup>st</sup> Thomas Gerard to the 1<sup>st</sup> Snow  
 Snow was with you the Jurisf. of the whole  
 Estate of the 1<sup>st</sup> Snow here in Maryland as for  
 money by him the 1<sup>st</sup> Thomas Gerard borrowed  
 of Snow Snow for the fitting for the 1<sup>st</sup> Snow

Ordered that the Snow read the  
 writ of removing the order a copy of the  
 writ at the house of Thomas Gerard shall be  
 sufficient notice to the 1<sup>st</sup> Thomas Gerard
