Then was read an Act sent from the lower house for the Amending & settling the Lower house for their Continuance.

Then was read an Act sent from the lower house for providing a Magazine voted to pass.

Then was read an Act for payment of the due from Criminals per found amended and voted to pass to be sent to the lower house for their consideration.

Then was read an Act for revising the laws within the Province voted to pass that all these Acts be sent to the lower house with the Amendment for their Continuance.

Then came from the lower house Mr. Calver Esq. with the following paper as an answer to the message sent to the lower house concerning the Petition with the Sasquesahanough Indians

(vizt) The Service of the lower house is as to the making good of the Petition with the Sasquesahanough Indians that ten Volunteers with a Captain be wayed upon any Emergent occasion when Government and Council shall think fit to be employed in assisting the Sasquesahanough Indians for the Continuance of the Petition
