By shows that we have as yet paid no wages due unto him for the imprisonment of Hannah Lee the Widow Mary Walter from the 14th of June until the 1st of October for other charges by her the prisoners incurred as for their conveying to Maryland for the sum of £1000 hundred pounds and £1000 hundred pounds of tobacco, and for the Indian prisoners with the charge of conveying them to St. Marys for the sum of one hundred eight hundred pounds & £1000 hundred pounds of tobacco, & say that as yet we have not had any knowledge of the time of the laying in publick leavy that he might at that time have presented his account to the Court in Charles County for the laying of the leavy of this County was from thence referred to this Assembly

The petition being taken into consideration the Court humbly trusts that your honors will be pleased to grant the order for the discharge
And he shall pray

After reading of which petition ordered that it be sent to the lower house for their consideration
