to be sent to the several respective Counties

Province may have sufficient notice thereof
so that the honorable the Chancellor be desired
to take care to see the same effectually done
with all convenient speed after the Disso-
lution of this Assembly And that every
Speaker of the County pay to the Chancellor said
the sum of two hundred
pounds of Tobacco for his tax of printed
papers And whosoever or who for ever
future it be not convenient to establish
by Law that the Chancellor for the time
being shall by writ to the Sheriff of every
County cause all such laws as shall
from hence to hence be enacted to be pub-
lished & printed as heretofore had
been done in England after this con-
firming. This is Recommended to the
Speaker by Charles Calvert
signed.
