In Compliance with your Request in your Message by Mr. Parnan and Mr. Shields his Excellency has been pleased to order the Attorney General to have his Petitions and other proper process of the Provincial Court, in order to examine Petitioners and to bring to condigne Punishment all or any person Whatsoever, who may Reasonably be supposed to have Embelliged the Record of Calvert County Court mentioned in Roger Boyces Petition.

And Whereas this is not the first offence of the like nature that has been represented to the Legislators of this Province, his Excellency recommends it to your Consideration whether it may not be advisable to make a particular Law this Session for the Punishment of such offences which may hereafter be committed within this Province.
