necessity. That the Governor & Council be empowered for three years
to raise regiments of men, Ammunition, Victuals, &c. other
necessary accommodation for their men to be raised, if occasion shall
require, not only for making of a War, but also for the
conducting of a Peace, w^t our neighbouring Indians, or other foreign
enemies. Yes or no? And voted

In the affirmative necessary.

Then Mr. Speaker requested Mr. Randolph, to give his opinion
w^t to the Upper House. That this house are ready to send them

And therupon the Upper House came into this house
and Resolved Both houses into a Grand Committee.

Where the Committee doth consider certain reasons presented
among the Indians, as to getting concluding a Peace & the
conformity of certain Articles to that end.

And it was Resolved by that Grand Committee that the
