

7th Did they shew y^e said Ribbons and Medall as a pledge of amity given them by the former Governours of this province and was y^e said Medall given to Major Truman or to any other English man or was it carryd back againe into y^e Forte.

8th Did Major Truman stay at the North side of Puseattaway Creek till y^e Indians came thither to him, or did he there Treat with them concerning the Management of y^e warre, ag^t y^e Tusquehannoughs 9th. Did y^e Tusquehannoughs ever offer any Treaty of peace or desire to continue friendship and whether did Major Truman ever demand Satisfaction from them for any Injuries done or tell them they were y^e persons which we suspected had Injured us.

The house is adjourned till 9 a clock, tomorrow Morning.

On Wednesday May y^e 17th 1676. at 9 a clock in y^e Morning y^e house mett present as Yesterday.

Ordered that for y^e more Expediencie Returns of y^e Examination of y^e Shantis to y^e severall Interrogatories touching y^e Murder of the Tusquehannoughs Indians W^m Russell is hereby empowered to prep boats and hands and other necessaries in order to y^e S^d Expediencie.

Ordered that the hon^{ble} Secretary doe forthwith Issue a writ of Superseas to Superseide y^e Capias ad Satisfaciendum mentioned in y^e petition exhibited to this house.

Noted that the Committee inspect all the Lawes of this Country for fees due to any person whatsoever by reason of their office, and ascertain all fees of all officers whatsoever within this province and draw up a Law for that purpose, that soe while the Right hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary is in this province of Jame may be fully settled and y^e his Lo^{ps} and upper house be desired that the hon^{ble} the Chanceller and Secretary may be joyned with the Committee of this house to make up a Committee of both houses for y^e inspecting and setting of y^e same.
