And thereupon a Member of this house presented a draught of a Proclamation drawn by Express Orders of the R<sup>ty</sup> Honble the Lord Proprietary in order to the quietting of possessions of such people who seek to be Received by the Said L<sup>ty</sup>.

And upon Reading of Said Proclamation this house doe conceive that the Said Proclamation will sufficiently answer the end of 4<sup>th</sup> Bill. And voted that of Said Proclamation be sent to the Lower house in answer to 4<sup>th</sup> part of the Message or Paper sent from the Lower house which relates to 4<sup>th</sup> Said bill, and dated of 4<sup>th</sup> first Instant.

Came in a petition Exhibited by Giles Stephens ag<sup>t</sup> Charles James for Release ag<sup>t</sup> of Said James his omission of returning his Certificate of Survey upon a warrant obtained by 4<sup>th</sup> Said Giles for 200 acres of lands bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> of August 74, and surveyed by the said James by virtue of 4<sup>th</sup> Said warrant, and upon hearing on both sides it is considered here of 4<sup>th</sup> Said James doe forthwith returne of Said Certificate of Survey to 4<sup>th</sup> Secretaries office and satisfye the Costs and Charges expended by 4<sup>th</sup> Said Giles Stephens in severall Journes to St. Maris about of Said business.
