Proclamation drawn by Express Orders of the R: Honble the Lord  
Proprietary in Order to the quietting of professions of such people who  
seeks to be Received by the Said Vice.

And upon Reading of Said Proclamation this House doe conceive  
that the Said Proclamation will sufficiently answer the end of the Bill.  
And voted that the Said Proclamation be sent to the Lower House in  
Answer to y<sup>e</sup> part of the Message or Papers sent from the Lower House  
which relates to the Said Bill, and dated y<sup>e</sup> first instant.

Came in a Petition Exhibited by Giles Stephens ag<sup>r</sup> Charles James for  
Relief ag<sup>r</sup> y<sup>e</sup> said James his omission of returning his Certificate of  
Survey upon a warrant obtained by y<sup>e</sup> said Giles for 300 Acres of Land  
bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> of August -74, and Surveyed by the said James  
by virtue of y<sup>e</sup> said warrant, and upon Hearing on both sides it is  
considered here y<sup>e</sup> said James doe forthwith returne y<sup>e</sup> said  
Certificate of Survey to y<sup>e</sup> Secretaries office and satisfye the Costs  
and Charges expended by y<sup>e</sup> said Giles Stephens in Several  
Journeys to St. Maries about y<sup>e</sup> said benefite.
