Rozier be impowered to examine of^r King of Mattawoman Touching of^r
Indian prisoners lately apprehended and delivered by him to Capt^r
Allen as alsoe to urge the said King of Mattawoman to examine the
said prisoners by such or the like Questions or Interrogatories hereafter
following. If by such Examination they the said Mr^r Addams &c may
fully satisfie themselves touching of^r Indians and designe of^r said
prisoners coming into this province, and thereupon may with all
speed transmitt there Report thereof to his Lord^rs and Councill
under their hands, who may thereby be able to Judge, whether of^r
said prisoners be deserving of Death, Sea or Noe, and to take speedy
order concerning them. Signed &c:

The Interrogatories, d^rg:

- 1^r. Whence did ye said prisoners come.
- 2^r. What doe of^r said prisoners pretend to be the end designed
of^r their coming into this province.
- 3^r. Did they come voluntarily or not.
4. Who did take or apprehend of^r said Indians.
5. Doth the King of Mattawoman Judge them to be friends, or to
come as Spies and for some evill intent.

The house is adjourned for an houre.

- 6^r. Whether the said Indians are of this province, and to what Town
they belong, how long they have been absent, and whence they have
been.
- 7^r. What Number of^r Enemie doth consist of from which the said
prisoners come and whether the said Enemie be in fforted or
where at present they are Resident, and who are their confederates
and what is their designe.

Ordered aforesay that there be such a nrooe many of the Neighbouring
Indians of the severall Indian Nations present at y^e Examinatioⁿ
as shall be thought fit to satisfie and assue of^r said Neighbouring
Indians that noe wrong or Injustice shall at y^e present or for the
future be done them.

Carried in the order of this house on Saturday last in Edmundson

to y^e Examinatioⁿ, being fully agreed on both sides it was found that
