1858 Your Lord^s Faithfull and humble Serv^t humbly pray for the future to prevent all discontents touching the same, That your Lord^s & would order a certaine Number to be elected in every County.

And that every person so elected, may be called to serve as a member of this house by your Lord^s writt and in case of y^e death or removall, to any office of any member for the future new writt, may be issued for the inhabitants of such Countys y^e deceased or removed Member were Delegates for to elect new ones in their stead, which said person be newly elected may likewise be sent for by your Lord^s Writt, soe y^e for y^e future the Members of this House may be y^e full choice of y^e people.

Upon present of this petition we have considered that to grant this petition is to strike wryg the Declaration of our dear Father relating to y^e Settlement of Assemblies. But yet have resolved to grant it, but do declare that we shall for y^e future exact y^e every member of assembly hereafter to be elected shall at his instance and before y^e election of the Officer take y^e Oath of Fidelity to us our Heires and Successors, and y^e Delegates now alreadie Elected to this assembly and admitted to be Called to this Session, shall at their instance into the House of Assembly take the like oath.
