wing may be served with the Summons prepared for him already.

Tuesday October 9th 1683.

The House mett and called, all present as yesterday.

Then was read what was done yesterday.

The Bill for the advancement of trade taken into further Consideration
and putt to the question whether a Salvo for the City of St. Marys;
that the Master shall not be prejudiced by the Act for Advancement
of trade shall be made to y^r said Bill, y^r a or Maye part in y^r Negative;

I voted that only four Commissioners be appointed for every County
for the said County, and ordered that y^r Members of this House
do nominate the said Commissioners for their respective Counties by
twelve a clocke today.
