They returned and say the Upper House is adjourned because they cannot  
deliver their Message.

The House adjourns till tomorrow Morning Seven a Clock.

Friday October 12<sup>th</sup> 1683.

The House met and called, all present as yesterday.

Then was read what was done yesterday.

Lower House of Assembly October 12<sup>th</sup> 1683.

This House have sent the bill for Advancement of Trade, because as  
it is finished, thereby to show the Intent of this House in nominating such  
several Commissioners for each County.

Mr. Thomas Buefford and Mr. Robert Cavile sent to the Upper House  
with the bill for Advancement of Trade, and the Message relating thereto.

They returned and say they have delivered the same.

Mr. Hatton and Capt. . . . . Sent to the Upper House with a Bill -

entitled an act providing in Case of accidents within this Governmente  
to be by this house. They returned and say they delivered the same.

Capt. . . . . from the Committee for Inspecting the Lawes brings a Bill  
entitled an act . . . . . goods and Chattells whose owners  
. . . . . read the first time.

Mr. . . . . from the Committee for Inspecting the Lawes moves this  
consider the Act Entitled an Act for punishmente such  
persons as Counterfeit of great scale. And to know if the house will  
commit the same to be new draune.

This House answers they will consider thereof.
