

Coll: Stevens from the Upper House brings into this House, a Bill Entitled
An Act providing in Case of Suddayns Accidents in this Government, & Sent
to by the Upper House.

M^r Robert Carver from the Committee for Inspecting the Lawes, brings
a Bill Entitled An Act for punishment of Certain offences against the Peace
and Safety of this Province, which was read the first time.

Coll: Stevens from the upper House brings the Bill for advancement of
Trade, and says that the upper House had Nothing to object against the Commission
nominated by this House and presented to his Lords.

M^r Carver sent to the upper House to know if the upper House is ready for
the Conference, appointed Yesterday to be this afternoon.

Returns and says the upper House will send word when ready.
Put to the question whether at the end of the Conference any Members
of this House shall have liberty to make any objection to any of the places
& appointed for Townes in the last Message relating thereto.

Voted in the affirmative.

Coll: Darnall acquaints this House that the upper House are ready for
the Conference in the Room where the upper House now sits.

This House adjourns into the Room where the upper House now sits,
and takes with them his Lords Ordinance and the Bill for Elections.
After the Conference ended this House returns to their own House hav-
ing first delivered his Lords Ordinance and the Bill for Elections to the
House for their further perusal.

Lower House of the Assembly October 12th 1683.

This House desires the upper House to take into Consideration the
objections that Capt Osborne a member of this House shall make to the places
appointed for Towne or Townes in Accomack River.

The House met and called, All present as yesterday.

Then was read what was done yesterday.

M^r Fitzby presents to this House the following Message, and says
he delivered the Message last night sent by him and Capt Osborne.

Upper House October 12th 1683.

This House for reasons offered by M^r Fitzby for alteration of places for
Townes in Cecil County, are willing the places be as followeth

1. At Capt. Shinn Creeke, William Price's Plantation in Elk River.
2. Tapsafras River, William Fitzby's Plantation.

3. At Norton Creeke, Signed for ders. Tho: Gunwin Clerk

Capt Osborne also reports to this House that the upper House desires
