

Bill. Stevens from Upper House brings into this House, a Bill Entituled An Act proceeding in Case of Sudden & accident in this Government, offered to by the Upper House.

Mr. Robert Barville from the Committee for Inspecting of Laws, brings a Bill Entituled An act for punishment of certain offences against peace and Safety of this Province, which was read a first time.

Bill. Stevens from the upper House brings a Bill for advancement of Trade, and says that the upper House had nothing to object at Commission nominated by this House and presented to His Lordship.

Mr. Barville sent to the Upper House to know if the Upper House is ready for the Conference, appointed yesterday to be this afternoon.

Returns and says the upper House will send word when ready.

Rid to the question whether at the end of the Conference any Members of this House shall have liberty to make any objection to any of the places appointed for Townes in y^e last Message relating thereto.

Voted in the affirmative.

Col^r Darnall acquaints this House that y^e Upper House are ready for the Conference in the room where the Upper House now sit.

This House adjourned into y^e Room where the upper House now sit.

And voted with them this Act Ordinance and the Bill for Elections.

After the Conference indeed this House return to their own House having first delivered the Act Ordinance and the Bill for Elections to y^e Upper House for their further perusal.

Upper House of Assembly October 12th 1683.

This House desire the upper House to take into Consideration the objections that Capt. Osborne a Member of this House shall make to y^e places appointed for Towne or Townes in proconsular Review.

The House met and called, all present as yesterday.

There was read what was done yesterday.

Upper House October 12th 1683.

This House for reasons offered by Mr. Fizley for alteration of places for Townes in Beaufort County, are willing the places be as followeth.

1. At Capt. John Creekie, William Francis Plantation in Elk River.

2. Yappafrog River, William Highs Plantation.

3. At Norton Creekie. Signed order - Tho: Greenwin Col^r
