Barre to the Owner or owners or any person interested in the said land whether
within or without this province or not. His Highness the Lord Proprietary of this
Province his Heirs and Successors saving the Rights hereby in this act to his
Highness his Heirs and Successors reserved.

Put to the question whether the foregoing Clause shall be added to the act
for Advancement of Trade (Yea or Nay). Voted in the Affirmative.

Mr. Richard Hall added to the Committee for inspecting the Laws for
drawing up a bill to lessen the Number of Horses within this province.

Major Wickes and Mr. Hojier sent to the Upper House to desire them more
particularly to absentyne the Places for Townes.

They returne and say that the upper house doe suppose the Commission
in the act mentioned have power to absentyne the Places soe that the
same be not too far from the Places in the Message of the 11th Instant
mentioned.

The house adjournes till to Morrow Morning seven a Clock.
