The house Adjournes Till to Morrow Morning 7 a Clocke.

Friday November 4th Second 1683.

The house mett and called, all present as Yesterday.

Then was read what was done Yesterday.

Then was read an Act for Changing of port or place of Trade in
Brittons Bay in St. Marys County of 2^d time.

The sayd bill read the 3^d time by Speciall Order of the house, and
then the question was putt whether the sayd Bill should pass.

Yea or Nay - voted in the affirmative.

Then was read a Bill ascertaining the true force and validity of
the Lawes of this Province, past in the absence of the Right Hon^{ble}
Lords Proprietary of this Province his heirs and Successors Lords and
Proprietarys thereof. The second time, and Committed for Amendments.

Capt. Smith sent to 4th opp^o house for 4th booke of Lawes.

He Returns and brings it with him.

Then was read a Bill Entituled An Act of Gratitude to and for a
Support for 4th Right Hon^{ble} Charles 4th and the heirs of his blood &c.
The second time, and 4th question if pass with amendments.

Yea or Nay - voted in 4th Negative.

It was then further put to the question. An Act for Continuing the
payment of the Disposition of 2 Shillings per Hogshead during the
life of the honorable bacilius 4th shall be new drawne, altering the
name of bacilius for Benedict Leonard Leonardo, and offered to
Consideracion of the Lower house. voted in 4th Affirmative.

Then was read a Bill Entituled an Act for Repeale of Certayne Lawes
the second time: and after debate, thereupon the question was putt whether
the sayd bill should pass to Enforcements, Yea or Nay.

voted In the Negative.

Then comes Mr. Secy Darnall and presents to this house the petition
of for 6478^o of Tobacco, due to 4th Estate of Daniell Crocker
of which petⁿ was endorsed as followeth, viz.
