Then Coll. Tauman of the Grand Committee of the Lower house desired to
know if the matter remarked, upon reading the perpetual lawes may
bee debated in the Committee.

After some debate upon $\frac{1}{2}$ Question it was resolved, that this Committee
may debate $\frac{1}{2}$ matter remarked upon $\frac{1}{2}$ Reading of $\frac{1}{2}$ said Lawes.

Then the Committee proceed, and upon consideration of an act
Touching Judicature - Resolved that the sayd Law is repealed in
ye. 1678. by an Act for Repeale of certayne Lawes: which act of
repeale being only disasented to in one Clause: that is to say: An act ag^t
Exporting His Lo^{ty}s Ordinance &c: the remaining part of the sayd
repealing act is in full force, and doe repealed $\frac{1}{2}$ Act, touching Judicature,
and therefore $\frac{1}{2}$ sayd act ought not to stand in the booke.

Upon consideration of an act Touching pagans.
Resolved that the sayd act stands repealed, by the repealing act made
Anno: 1678: and therefore ought not to remaine in the booke.

An act for punishing certayne offences ag^t $\frac{1}{2}$ peace &c: Upon debate of the
said act: Resolved that a new bill be prepared instead thereof.

An act prohibiting $\frac{1}{2}$ transportacion &c: of His Lo^{ty}s Ordinance &c:
Resolved that a new bill be drawne and presented to His Lo^{ty} for His
assent: Instead of that act.

An act for taking the Oath of Fidelity &c: Read. Resolved that the sayd
act be amended by adding into $\frac{1}{2}$ Oath, And saving of our allegiance
to His Sacred Majesty.

Resolved thereupon that the sayd act is repealed, by an act made
An^o: 1681: and ought not to remaine in the booke.

An act appointing certayne officers. Read and Resolved that the sayd
act is Temporary and ought to stand in the booke as such.

An act imposing a penalty, on such as shall dispossesse of Tobacco, Seize
and received by $\frac{1}{2}$ Sher: and others - Read and thereupon Resolved
that $\frac{1}{2}$ sayd act is repealed: and therefore ought not to be continued
in the booke of Lawes.

An act relating to Negroes and Slaves. Read and Resolved to be repealed
by an act made Anno: 1681: Except one clause.

An act displaying one Clause, in an act, touching Hogg and Marling
cattle, Read, Debated, and thereupon Resolved, that $\frac{1}{2}$ sayd act is repealed
by a particular act made An^o: 1671: and by an act to repeal made
Anno: 1678: Therefore not to stand in $\frac{1}{2}$ booke of Lawes.
