

9th An act for Explication of that Clause in an act made in the time of Capt. Stone 1649. Touching Hogs and Marshing battle in his Lopp's booke of Lawes (mentioned is by an act made anno. 1671). Repealed.
10th Memorandum. That a new Law be made touching Hogs and Marshing battle.

11th Resolved that an act for continuing of peace with and protection of us. - That the last Enacting Clause and Words be repealed if thought convenient.

12th Resolved that the act for killing of Wolves be taken into Consideration

13th An act for Securing Orphans Estates, made Anno: 1671: is repealed in Anno: 1681: by a new Law made for that purpose.

14th An act for the Support of his Lopp: made Anno: 1671. to be taken into Consideration.

15th An act of Gratitude to his Excellency Charles Sc. made Anno: 1674. To be Considered off.

16th An act for limiting of County Clerkes Fees, to be inscribed into the new booke.

17th A Supplementary act to the act for officers Fees, made Anno: 1681: To be inscribed into the new Booke.

8th To the eighth. That the act imposing a penalty on all such who shall dispose of Tobacco seized and received by the Hon. the Duties as a Temporary act.

9th To the ninth, That the act for Explication of that Clause in an act.
