Ordered ^{the} ^{the} persons deliver ^{the} message to ^{the} upper House as soon as they sitt and soe proceed upon their Charge.

The House Adjourn till to Morrow (Morning 7 o'clock.

Thursday April 17th 1684.

The House mett and called - All present as yesterday.

Then was read what was done Yesterday.

(Mr. Francis Hutchins a Member of this House hitherto absent now presents himself and sayd ^{the} a few days before the meeting of this Assembly, he broake his arme, and was thereby rendered unable to attend this House sooner, This Excuse being apparent is admitted. and he takes his place.

The Committee for the Address, and regulating the Schedule made report of their proceedings, as followeth.

First - they present the Address faire written, which was read.
