

both houses, for his Lopp^t consent to y^r same, which bill conveys the
sense of two other acts, one Entituled an Act for Levying of Wars within
this province, and the other an act Concerning Raising Money within
this province without y^r Consent of an Assembly, and repealed y^r same.

It was thereupon put to the vote by the Members of the Upper House
in Committee whether y^r said bill shall pass as it is y^r a or may:

Past in the Negative.

Yet the Upper House say that if y^r Act for Support of his Lopp^t.
Act of Gratitude, may be considered together with the same, and putt
into full terms - That then the said three bills may be presented to his
Lopp^t together, to which the Lower house did not agree.

There was read an act Improving the Governor and Councill
to make war and peace without the bounds of that province made
Anno: 1666: and upon debate appeared to be perpetuated in An: 1676
and Repealed in Anno: 1678: But upon y^r whole it was agreed by both
houses to bee fallen of it selfe and ought not to stand in y^r New Book of Laws
as an act for killing of Wolves. Read and agreed that a new bill be drawn
and made a temporary law.

An act for diminishing of officers fees Read, and agreed by both houses
that y^r Act be amended, and y^r fee now taken by the Secretaries for
patients Regulated.

An Act for County Clerks fees, Read, and agreed that the said act be
entered in y^r bookes amongst the perpetuall Laws.

A Supplementary act to y^r Act for Officers fees, Read, and agreed to be
entered amongst y^r perpetuall Laws.

The Committee adjourne to the house.

Mr Speaker reassumes the chair.

There was read in this house the proceedings of the grand Committee
of yesterday and today.

(Mr Secretary Darnall brings a paper from the upper house which

(Moved by a member of this house y^r t^e land given by William Berry

accordingly in the said Supplementary act, it being the humble request
of all y^r inhabitants there and divers others in that County, the Count
house being thereon built at the great Charge of the County.
