of Cornwallis or Leakins, or both at y<sup>e</sup> Discretion of the Commissioners:

Mr. Robert Carvile, Mr. Clement Hill and Mr. Richard Hall, being appointed  
A Committee for drawing up y<sup>e</sup> Supplementary act to y<sup>e</sup> act for Advance-  
ment of Trade, are Ordered to report to the upper house y<sup>e</sup> Advice and  
Alteracions of Townes afores<sup>d</sup>. and to proceed upon their Charge.

Then was Ordered y<sup>e</sup> following Message.

Lower house of Assembly April y<sup>e</sup> 19<sup>th</sup> 1684.

Upon perusal of the said Deposition of William Blanckinsten sent to  
this house from the upper house, affirming the Inability of Jacob Young to  
Travell to this Assembly, this house doe concur with the upper house  
in admitting the said deposition in excuse of y<sup>e</sup> said Jacob to have him  
and his baile for not appearing at this meeting of Assembly.

Which being read and signed was sent to y<sup>e</sup> upper house by Mr. Statton  
and Maj<sup>r</sup> Joseph Weekes.

They Returne and say they have delivered the same.

The Committees being all out upon their severall busineses, and this  
house having more then busines before them.

The house Adjourned till Munday Morning Eight a Clock.

Munday April y<sup>e</sup> 21<sup>th</sup> 1684.

The house met, and Called, all present as on Saturday.

Then was read what was done on Saturday.

The Committee for drawing up y<sup>e</sup> Supplementary act to y<sup>e</sup> act for  
Advancement of Trade goe upon their Charge.

Then was read a bill Entitled an Act of Certayning the true force and  
validity of y<sup>e</sup> Lawes of this Province past and to be past in the absence of y<sup>e</sup>  
Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord and Proprietary and his Heirs and Successors, Lords and  
proprietors of this Province: The first time.

The Committees come into y<sup>e</sup> house, and the Committee for  
drawing up y<sup>e</sup> Supplementary act and other bills, present to the house  
three bills Entitled as followeth:

An Act Touching Levying of Warre and Defraying y<sup>e</sup> publique Charge  
of this Province which was read the first time.

An Act of Excessive Ofuy. which was read the first time, and

An Act for Raising a Supply for his Maj<sup>ties</sup> Extraordinary occasions.

Which was read the first time.

A Bill Entitled an act touching Levying of Warre &c: read y<sup>e</sup> second time  
and by Speciall Order of the house and past to Ingrossment.
