Upon Debate of Two Messages sent this day to this House, about Townes  
 was drawne y<sup>e</sup> following Message - (vizt.)

Lower House of Assembly April 21<sup>st</sup> 1684.

This House concurs with y<sup>e</sup> Upper in their two Votes this day sent, that  
 a Towne be appointed at or nere Tipquin on the South Side of Mantecoke  
 River, as alsoe at the head of protobacco Creeke, And this House desire to  
 knowe if the upper House doe consent to y<sup>e</sup> severall Votes and places  
 agreed on by this House, and mentioned in a list sent to the upper House  
 on Saturday last, Signed for order, C. Boteler, Clk. of y<sup>e</sup> Lower House &c.

Which being read and signed was sent to y<sup>e</sup> upper House by Capt.  
 Smith and Mr. Hutton.

Mr. Jeery Dainall brings a Message from the upper House which  
 being read is as followeth (vizt.) -

Upper House April 21<sup>st</sup> 1684:

This House doe concur in all points with the lower House in their  
 Message on Saturday last relating to Townes, according to their severall  
 Votes therein mentioned -

A Bill Entituled an Act for Killing of Wolves.

A Bill Entituled an Act for Appoynting Court Dayes in each (respective  
 County -

A Bill Entituled an Act for Taking y<sup>e</sup> Oath of Fidelity &c.

Every of which bills received its first Reading in this House towards  
 its passage -

Then was read the petition of Michaell Janey, for a Towne in  
 Battle Creeke upon his Land, And that the same may be soe layd out  
 as to reserve his houses thereon built to himselfe - Whereupon was Endorsed  
 as followeth - Upper House April 21<sup>st</sup> 1684:
