

Voted whether a Bill shall be drawn to make ports in Pottowattamie and Monocan Rivers, Carried in the Negative.

Mr. Speaker orders all Committees to attend in the afternoon, and Adjoins the House till two of the clock -

Post Meridiem - The House again Met, and the following & Proposals from His Ex: the Governor in Council are laid before them (Divd.)

1st - That in the additional Act for Securing Orphans Estates a Clause be added that the personal Estate be sold by out Lot - Whereupon voted in the House if such Clause shall be added and Carried in the Negative.

2^d - That a Clause be inserted in the additional Act to Religion, that the Clarke of the Vestry shall Register all Births, Marriages, and Burials, and the Names of all Servants Coming into this Province, and the Names of the places from whence they come, for which Registering the Clarke to have six pounds of Tobacco per name,

Voted Whether the Clarke of the County or Clarke of the Vestry shall keep such Register, and Carried by Majority of Voices - that the Clarke of the Vestry shall keep the same -

3rd Proposed that a Brass Standard of Weights and good Measures be sent for out of England, to be kept in the Secretaries Office by which the several County Standards in this Province upon all occasions may be tried -

Upon which Debated in the House if it will not be more convenient, that the Com^r: of the several Countys send for one brass halfe hundred weight to be kept as af^d to the End af^d by the Clarkes of the respective Countys -

And thereupon Resolved that the Com^r: of the several Countys send for such an halfe hundred weight to be kept as af^d to the End af^d

4th Proposed that some Method be prescribed, for Redressing of the Under Valuement of the publique Faith -

Whereas - It is the Sense of the House that the several Sheriffs in this Province, are within the provision of the Act for the Relief of Debtors

5th Proposed that a Division be made of St. Marys, Charles and Calvert Countys -

Voted - if such division shall be made, and Carried in the Negative
The House Adjoins till to morrow Morning at 4 of the clock -
