Mr. Speaker moves the House that his Ex: Recommends to them the Setting of Publicke Ferry's - Referred to the next Assembly.

Upon Reading the Committee of Agravances Reporte relating to Shoemakers and Tanners the same is referred to the next Assembly.

Major John Thompson recommended by the House to receive of Import upon Liquors at the Head of the Bay.

The Petition of the People Called Quakers, being Rec'd from His Ex: and the honble his Matys Council to this House.

'Tis the opinion of the house, that as to the first part thereof viz: dispensing with their Corporeal Oaths, 'tis respeccfully Contrary to the known Laws of the Kingdom of England - And therefore not fit to be dispensed with - And as to the second part of the petition & relating to the 40^d of this House will not make any distinction but continue them under the same circumstances with all other their Matys good Subjects as to the Payment thereof.
