

The House think fit to reject the same, for that within the said parts & there are not people enough to be had to serve as Com^{rs} Jurymen and other Officers, without going into Court for such whose business is to attend the County Courts, and therefore the same is thought burthen some.

That the House would Queere, whether the act made in Gov^{rs} Co^{rs} plays tyne for Navall Officers Fees ought not to be Repealed and especially that Clause relating to Shippes built in the Country.

Resolved that the Committee of Laws enquire thereinto. That the House would take into Consideration upon tryalls in the provinciall C^{ts} where the Dinnage shall arise that they would inspect the act relating thereto and propose some Salvo to it.

Referred to the Consideration of a full House on Thursday next That the Law for regulating appeals and writts of Error be so exp^lained, that the King be not bound up thereby from appealing for any Summe, and that in Case the Govern^r be sick or a party in any appeal the same may be heard before the Chief Chancellor and 4 more.

It is the opinion of this House that the King is not thereby debarr'd from appealing for any Summe whatever. And that his Roy^{ty} by Com^{on} and the Great State may in such Cases propose provide for the hearing of appeals before such Chief Chancellor and 4 more.

Also Resolved by the House that if the principall Debtors Damages shall amount to or exceed the Summe of 10000^l that in such Cases writts of Error shall lie from the Judgment of the provinciall Court.

That the Law be exp^lained about furs whether furs and Skins exported out of Pennsylvania into this Province upon being again exported shall not pay duty as others.

Referred to the Consideration of the Committee of Laws. That an Imposition be layd upon European Goods imported into this Province upon the exporting the same into Pennsylvania or else where, the Inhabitants of this Province making Oath to their property in them before such exportation to be exempted from said duty.

A Bill already Ord^d to be prepared therefore.

What shall be done with the Money already levied by the act for the Imposition upon furs and other Commodities exported. Whether it will not be convenient to expend the same in building a small School and Mainteyning a School Master.

Resolved that the Money thereby raised be kept in Bankes. That the House would take in to Consideration the Repealing of the act for the exportation of Beere, Elke Skins and Raw Hides, and
