at St. Marks in Sep<sup>r</sup>. 1694. to Audite the Acc<sup>t</sup>. of Mr. Plater and other  
Receivers of y<sup>e</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> P. Salt. on Rums de may bring in their Report to this  
House. And that all Treasurers, Navale officers and other Collectors  
may bring in their Acc<sup>t</sup>. to this House so that it maybe knowne and  
an Acc<sup>t</sup>. taken of all Sumes that are in any Mans hands belonging  
to the publique.

Upon reading the above Report Ordered, the publique Treasurers  
of this Province produce their Acc<sup>t</sup>. to this House on Munday next.  
Mr. Elisha Hall, his petition being read Ordered that the Committee  
of Laws prepare a Bill for confirming the Titles of all those persons  
who according to former Acts of Assembly have taken up Lots in  
Towns and built thereon.
